

PLAN AND PREPARE:

Prepare your surfaces. Clean and rough-up the surface. Wear protective gloves.

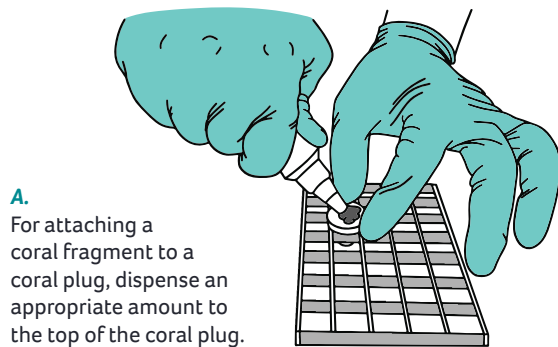


*Surfaces do not need to be dry.

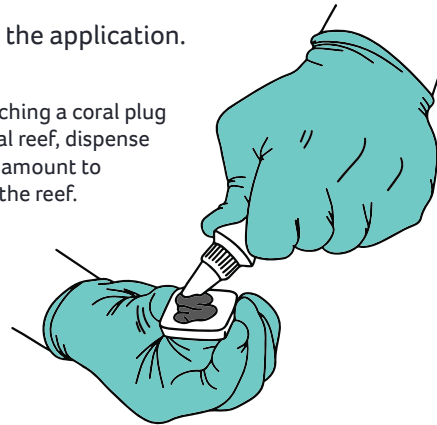

APPLY:

Deliberately squeeze out at point of use. Use an amount relative to the application.



B.
For attaching a coral plug to a coral reef, dispense a larger amount to stick to the reef.



*SeaTak™ can be applied wet or dry. Be deliberate in your application. The more you work with it in a moist environment, a skin will begin to form and the adhesive will lose its underwater tackiness.

LEAVE TO SET:

SeaTak™ will withstand a gentle current immediately and it will withstand a tide change within a couple of hours of curing. By the next day, SeaTak™ will have a 50% - 80% cure and will continue to strengthen throughout the week.



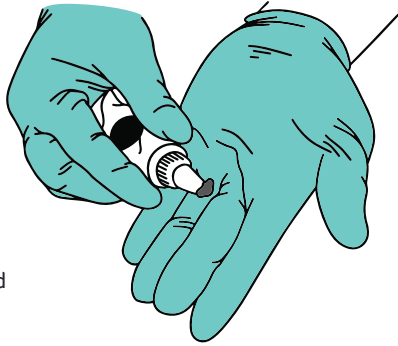
*Moisture is the activator, as such, SeaTak™ will begin to cure immediately.

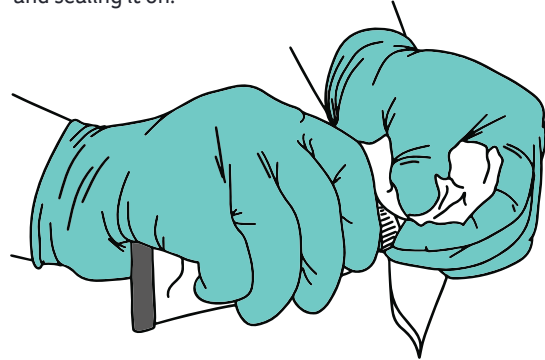
CLEANUP:

Clean up immediately.

A. Clean up with an applicator tip left on the tube: Let blob of SeaTak™ cure on end of applicator tip as it will turn into the cap and seal until removed for the next time.



B. Clean up with screw on cap. Be sure to clean screw cap threads to prevent the cap from sticking to the tube and sealing it on.



*Uncured adhesive can be cleaned up with acetone or denatured alcohol. Cured adhesive will need to be mechanically removed by sanding or chipping.

STORAGE

Store SeaTak™ with cap firmly placed on tube. SeaTak™ will store safely for 6 months in a cool dry place at 30° - 80°F.

WARNING:
