5 Step Installation Process:

Recommended Tools:


- Drill
- Stud finder
- 1/2" Drill Bit
- Level
- Measuring tape
- Pencil




1. IDENTIFY
Choose the desired height and shelf location - Use the stud finder to locate wall stud - finding the center is critical



2. Locate
Mark by using the level and draw a cross-hair pattern vertically & horizontally for the targeted location during the next step



3. Align & Drill
Use the provided drilling jig to identify the cross-hairs for proper drilling support - simply align, hold firmly and drill the hole

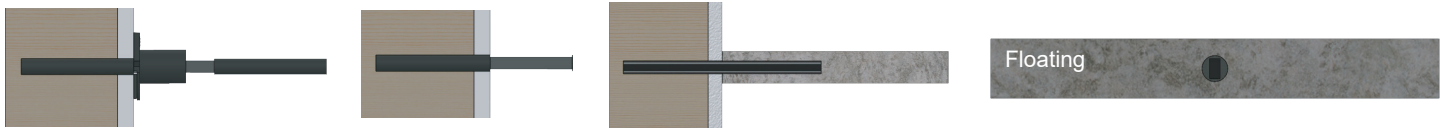


4. ADHERE & INSERT
Use the provided adhesive to lightly coat the outside of the sleeve - very important that you work quick and make sure the sleeve is properly aligned & plumb



5. PLACE
Carefully slide the CarbonBar rod in place for desired type of floating shelf support.
