Substrate Preparation

- ✓ Ensure bonding surfaces are clean, dry, and free from dust, oil, and debris
- ✓ Wipe with isopropyl alcohol or denatured alcohol before bonding
- ✓ Always perform a test bond before large-scale fabrication to confirm compatibility and color match

Applications Instructions

Step 1- Use a 10:1 ratio Integra-approved cartridge dispenser. Step 2- Insert cartridge into dispenser and purge until both components uniformly flow out. Step 3 - Attach mix tip to the nozzle of the cartridge then purge material until a consistent color is reached. Step 4 - Apply adhesive in a consistent bead directly to the substrate, ensuring enough material for a

small amount of squeeze out. Step 5 - Clamp with the right pressure or support components as required until fixture time is reached. Step 6 - Remove excess adhesive within the working time. For full instructions refer to 'Cartridge Application Procedure' document. Step 7 - Once full cure is achieved, remove any clamps and clean as needed.

Storage & Shelf Life

Store upright between 60-80°F (16-27°C) in a cool, dry place. Long-term exposure to higher temperatures will reduce shelf

life and alter cure properties. Do not freeze. See MFG data on cartridge for expiration information.
